Grenville crossed the bar on April 10 1997 in a Canberra hospice suffering from cancer just a few weeks after his diagnosis.

Sadly we only got to meet him twice, once at our inaugural meeting in 1995 and again at the MN memorial weekend in Canberra in 96.

The photo, the best I have off him is cut from the group photo at our inaugural meeting.

His wartime MN service included the now famous or infamous convoy SC107 of November 1942 The convoy escorted by a very weak escort was attacked by a U-Boat Wolf pack which sank 15 out of the 42 ship that had left Sydney, Nova Scotia on 24 October 1942.

Later he was on T124X articles with 'Operation Pluto' the laying of a fuel pipeline across the channel after the Normandy invasion.

He left the sea in late 1946 working in London for a few years before emigrating to Australia.
